

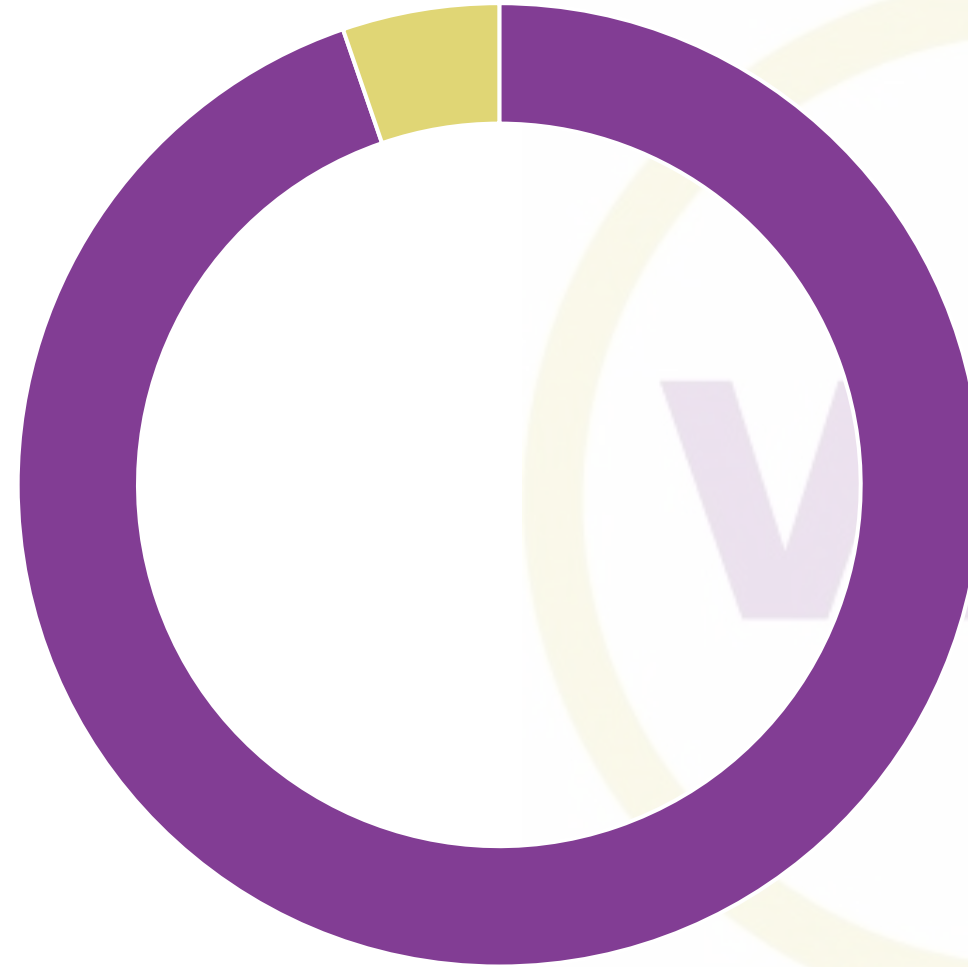

Felt like a lot of sitting down and listening'</i>	<i>'I think 5 minutes to wrap the day up with everyone would have ended it better'</i>	<i>'Maybe some time allocated to introduce some of the attendees and the organisations they are representing to ensure people don't miss out on valuable networking opportunities'</i>	<i>'We encourage our staff to use sustainable forms of transport (trains, buses, cycle etc) as such this can make it difficult to attend events that start early in the morning a later start time for future events would be a great help!'</i>
<i>'Have more interactive sessions'</i>	<i>'Time at the end to come back together around next steps'</i>	<i>'I am new to this particular network. Would like to see a place or person where I can exchange my contact details with to create an opportunity to be able to talk about my role'</i>	<i>'Very city focused yet it is LLR so it would be nice to talk about other barriers including rurality, barriers to opening youth centres in smaller areas outside of cities and have discussions where we can advocate for this'</i>

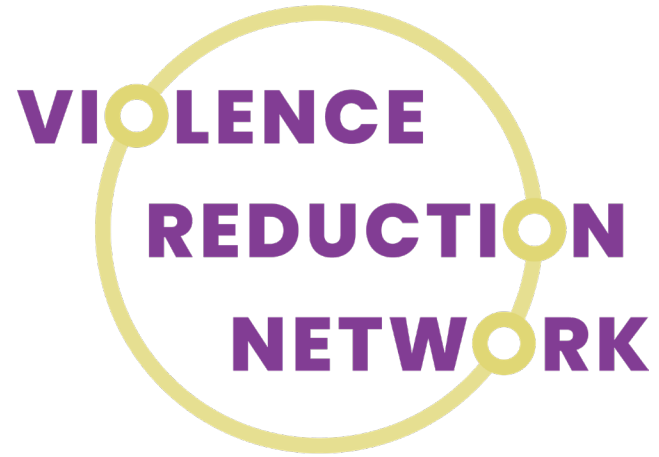
